## Suggested Types of Exhibits & Performances

- Visual Arts displays ~ such as photography, painting, sculpture, textiles, and ceramics
  - Performing arts ~ such as dance, acoustic music, storytelling
  - Cultural programs ~ such as historical displays or presentations

## General Use Information

- Display, event, or performance must be free and open to the public and not disrupt public accessibility to the Depot.
- Staff from the Department of Parks & Recreation will be on site throughout the public hours. Set up can begin 15 minutes prior to the public open hours.
- User(s) are completely responsible for providing all of their own display materials, such as tables & linens or display racks.
- Users must independently set up, tear down, and clean up after display or performance.
- All displays and materials must be free-standing. Tape, tacks, staples, and poster putty are all prohibited.
