Boise City Department of Arts & History Seeks Artists to Implement an Audio-Visual Performance

Project during the 2018 Treefort Music Fest

Opportunity:

Boise City Department of Arts & History invites artists to submit proposals for an opportunity to engage the public with audio/visual performance projects during Treefort Music Fest in 2018, presently scheduled for March 21st - March 25th, 2018. The Audio-Visual Services shall be required to perform during these dates, the duration and timeframe shall be determined based on individual projects. The selected artist(s) or artist team(s) shall be commissioned in a combined project total up to \$5,000 to create an innovative Performance Project that engages a diverse public audience. The City may select up to three artists or artist teams to implement their project proposal.

Project Information:

Artists are welcome to submit proposals using new or existing works which take the form of a performance. The theme is open, but the content must be appropriate for all members of the public. Performances can be proposed for a specific site/location or can be freeform.

Once selected, Public Art Staff shall work with selected artists to determine a location that fits the needs of the proposed project. Locations must be fully accessible and provide a free experience to all members of the public.

Artists shall be required to provide all tools, equipment, technology, knowledge and labor necessary to successfully execute on the proposed project.

Artists shall be required to professionally document the project through video and photo recording. The City shall retain ownership of the video and photo documentation as a part of the City's permanent collection and may choose to display the work publicly, at a later date.

The City shall also request ownership of props/costumes/artifacts that are generated by or for the performance for accession into the City's permanent collections with the intent of future public display. Items to be owned by the city shall be negotiated during the contracting phase.

Artists shall retain ownership of the copyright of the works.

Evaluation Process

Applications shall be submitted in a format that allows uniform review and easy access to information by the Evaluation Panel, which is made up of funding stakeholders, an Arts & History Commissioner, and other artists. The Applications are to be clear and concise. The Application package shall contain the following information:

1. Application Form (Pass/Fail)

Fill out / sign the Application Form/Signature Page and submit as your first document.

2. Letter of Interest (Pass/Fail)

- o Include a one-page letter addressing why you're interested in this opportunity and your related experience or qualifications.
- o Describe how the applicant is able to provide responsive services for an audio-visual performance that meets the needs of the City of Boise for this project.

3. Artist Resume (Pass/Fail)

Include a resume and / or brief summary of the Artist or Artist Team's qualifications and / or past experience. Emerging artists are encouraged to apply.

4. JPEG Images or AVI Video of current and past work (100 pts.)

Images are to be in JPEG Format, 300 dpi, not larger than 10" on the longest side.

Provide up to ten images of your past work, current work, and/or images of the proposed project as separate files in JPEG format attachments in the application email, or on a CD or Thumb Drive, which demonstrate your ability to meet the defined project opportunity.

5. Image List (Pass/Fail)

Please use the provided form to list the information for the submitted images: title, type of work (painting, sculpture, installation), material(s), date and any comments.

6. Project Proposal (200 pts.)

- o Describe, in detail, the proposed work.
- o Renderings, mock ups, or visual examples of the project are required.
- o Provide all technical details and specifications regarding the installation.
- Please include an itemized budget which includes required equipment, the potential of hiring of a professional to document the work, materials, time, tools and any other expenses.
- o Provide visual examples and budget information in separate files.
- Written description should be no more than 2 pages.
